## Big Brother & Big Sister Job Description

### ❖ **Mentoring/Relationship Building**

- You will have 5-8 campers in grades 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> assigned to you
- Each of these campers is your little sister/brother
- PRAY for them each morning and night. Pray with them individually at least once
- Play with and help supervise campers during campers' choice, after dinner, etc.
- Find ways to be WITH your campers: do what they want to do; rotate your time to be with each one on a different day.
- Dinner is eaten with your little sisters/brothers and will be set up with separate tables for each group.
- Devotional time with 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders in evening (after follies).

### ❖ **Assist Cabin Counselors**

- Each cabin will have 2 big brothers/sisters to assist cabin counselors
- Help the campers feel comfortable, get rest, and build relationships
- Aid the other cabin counselors in any way needed
- Be responsible, mature, and a positive role model

### ❖ **Journey Group leader**

You will be a co-leader of a 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade journey group

### ❖ **Games co-captains or event coordinators**

You will be paired with staff as captains of games teams or assigned as an activity judge. You need to be the "cheerleader" for the team. Make sure that campers aren't left out of activities. Also assist sports directors with set-up as needed (i.e. water balloons).

### ❖ **General helpers**

- Seek out opportunities to serve, assist, and meet needs of campers AND staff.
- Be involved with campers during activities to make them successful.
- Assist dining hall staff with tables, chairs, clean up, etc
- Assist with worship services as needed
- Assist with camp set up, registration, and clean up

### ❖ **Meet with our team**

- Attend Big Brother/Sister training day on June 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- Arrive for Junior Week of Camp K by 5:30pm on Saturday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### ❖ **Serve, LOVE, and play**

Be willing to EMPTY yourself for the sake of the campers. Remember the goal: for them to draw closer to the Lord through their relationship with you.
